A durable, lightweight, and mountable or transportable box containing 3 pieces of PPE (Personal Protective Equipment), a high-resolution video screen with a 1-minute bilingual emergency instruction video, a 5+ minute training video, a tagging system for inventory management, and a charging cord. The box holds user-supplied naloxone.

#### ONEbox® Co-Location / \$100



A high-resolution video screen with a 1-minute bilingual emergency instruction video, a 5+ minute training video, 2 pieces of PPE, and a charging cord. It attaches via double-stick tape and is designed for installation in various locations, including vending machines, AEDs, fire extinguishers, and first aid kits, and other overdose response boxes for enhanced opioid overdose emergency response.

### ONEbox® Flex / \$50



A mountable or transportable version of the **ONEbox®** with a QR code directing users to the same emergency video as the **ONEbox®** Classic. It includes 3 pieces of PPE, written instructions, a tagging system, and an installation/maintenance SOP.
